

INTERNET ACRONYMS (LOL)

The use of acronyms has exploded when it comes to online communication.

You could be forgiven for thinking it's not English anymore.

Some acronyms are more common and some more obvious than others. Others cause confusion for the older generation.

For example, the online acronym 'LOL' is commonly known to represent 'Laugh Out Loud' however some may interpret it as 'Lots of Love'. It is therefore important to contextualise the use of an acronym.

Children, and more so teens, are regular users of acronyms due to the large volume of messages travelling back and forth. It's quicker.

Acronyms can be used with any program where users send and receive messages, such as:

- Email (not as common)
- Text messaging
- Messaging programs (eg.Kik, Wats App, Facebook Chat, i Message)
- Social networking programs (Instagram, Tik Tok and Snapchat)
- Online gaming (All games that have text based communication functionality)
